

I. Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS)

A. Bilateral Program (Type A)

- 1. Application receiving agencies: Dispatching Department of your home country
 - The dispatching department is usually the Chinese embassy or consulates in your country, the Ministry of Education or authorities with the same functions in your country, or other relative authorities or organizations, etc.
- 2. Application time: usually from early January to early April
 - ▶ For specific application time, please consult the dispatching department.
- 3. Application Procedures



Flow Chart – International Students Applying for CGS Type A

(Specific procedures are subject to requirements given by the dispatching departments and the CSC)

- a) The applicant shall consult the dispatching department about application procedures and file an application with the dispatching department;
- b) The dispatching department will review the application and submit the recommended applicants' information and documents to the Chinese Scholarship Council (hereinafter referred to as CSC);

- c) The CSC will organize the university to examine the applicant. The university will review the application documents, interview the applicants, and submit the pre-admission list back to the CSC;
- d) The CSC will examine the pre-admitted applicants' eligibility and finalize the short-list candidates.

- 4. Matters Needing Attention
 - a) The applicant can consult the dispatching departments and get the *Operation Instructions of the Chinese Government Scholarship Information System* as well as the **application receiving agency number**;
 - b) The CSC will not accept individual applications;
 - c) The applicant must follow the instructions of Renmin University of China (hereinafter referred to as RUC) and go through all the admission procedures as required, including registering on our website, taking the written exam or an interview, etc. Specific requirements and timetable will be informed by the International Students Office (hereinafter referred to as ISO) and the School;
 - d) Please check your email regularly after submitting the application to ensure the smooth progress of admission; after receiving the email from RUC, please check your email on a daily basis in case of missing any notices, which could affect your admission;
 - e) CGS Type A applicants who intend to apply for the degree programs (including undergraduate program, master degree program and Ph.D. program) taught in Chinese shall submit the language test report. The following conditions apply.
 - i. The applicant should submit an HSK report with Level 4 at least.

- ii. If the applicant submits an **HSK Level 4 or 5** report, the school will test the applicant's Chinese language proficiency during the interview. If the applicant passes the test, the one-year Chinese language preparatory course (hereinafter referred to as CLPC) will be required (under the support of CSC); otherwise, the applicant will not be admitted. Before the end of the CLPC, the student must submit an HSK Level 6 report to the university to start the major study. If the student fails to reach Level 6, the university will evaluate their Chinese proficiency and overall academic performance when taking the CLPC, and decide whether to apply to CSC for another year of CLPC. If the student shows a bad academic record during the first year of CLPC or fails to obtain an HSK Level 6 report after two years of CLPC, the university will report the CSC and apply for cancelling the major study qualification of this student.
- iii. If the applicant submits an HSK Level 6 report with the total score no lower than 180 points and sub-category scores no lower than 60 points, the CLPC will not be required.
- f) Renmin University of China reserves the right to require the applicant to submit relevant supporting documents.

B. Chinese University Program (Type B)

- 1. Application receiving agency: Renmin University of China (No. 10002)
- 2. Application time: November 15, 2021 to April 30, 2022
- 3. Application Procedures
 - a) The applicant shall apply to RUC and the CSC at the same time;
 - b) RUC will view the applicant as self-supported and start the admission procedures,

including reviewing the application documents and examining the applicants;

- c) The university will carry out a comprehensive evaluation of the applicants based on the documents they provided, their examination performance and overall capabilities, and submit the scholarship recommendation list to the CSC;
- d) The CSC will review and finalize the admission list;
- e) The university will notify the admission result to the students and send out their admission documents.

4. Requirements

There are three programs that our university offer through CSC scholarship, including the University Postgraduate Program, the Silk Road Scholarship Program and the Sino-African Friendship Scholarship Program. In addition to the basic admission requirements, applicants shall fulfill the requirements listed below:

- a) University Postgraduate Program, Sino-African Friendship Scholarship Program:
 - i. Available to master degree program and Ph.D. program applicants only;
 - ii. Sino-African Friendship Scholarship Program is available to applicants from African countries only;
 - iii. The two programs have the same application majors available. Detail information is listed in Affiliation 1.
- b) Silk Road Scholarship Program:
 - i. Available to degree program applicants from the Belt and Road Initiative partner countries;
 - ii. For detailed information about application majors available, please refer to the *Major List* in Affiliation 2.

- 5. Matters Needing Attention
 - a) The applicant must apply to RUC and the CSC at the same time.
 - ▶ RUC Online Application System for International Students: international.ruc.edu.cn
 - Chinese Government Scholarship Information System: studyinchina.csc.edu.cn
 - b) When applying on CGS Information System, choose 'Type B Application' for [Input Application Information], and input '10002' for [Application Receiving Agency].
 - c) The applicant must apply **as a self-supported applicant** first on our system and be admitted as a self-supported student. During the application session, the applicant must submit the application documents and take the examinations. For detailed information, please refer to the 2022 *Enrollment Guide*.
 - d) When sending out the hard copies of application documents, please send along the *Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship* which is automatically generated by the CGS Information System after successful registration.

C. Designated Scholarship Programs & CSC-sponsored Student Exchange Program

In addition to the two main programs mentioned above, Renmin University of China also accepts students supported by CGS Designated Scholarship Programs or CGS Student Exchange Program. The Designated Scholarship Programs include the Great Wall Program, the EU Program, the AUN Program, the PIF Program, etc. For detailed information on the application procedures and requirements of the programs mentioned, please refer to the *Application Guide for Chinese Government Scholarship*:

II. International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship (ICLTS)

- Those who intend to apply for the scholarship must first get recommended by the Recommending Institutions, including but not limited to:
 - a) Confucius Institutes or independently operated Confucius Classrooms;
 - b) Certain HSK test centers;
 - c) Chinese language (education) departments of foreign universities;
 - d) Professional associations for Chinese language instruction of other countries;
 - e) Chinese embassies or consulates abroad.
- 2. Application time: March to Mid-May for Fall Semester

March to Mid-November for Spring Semester

- 3. Scholarship Types
 - a) Chinese Language Program (One-Academic-Year or One-Semester study)
 - b) Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (hereinafter referred to as MTCSOL)
- 4. Application Procedures
 - a) The applicant shall contact the Recommending Institutions on their own and get the recommendation first;
 - b) The Center for Language Education and Cooperation (hereinafter referred to as CLEC) will organize the recommended applicants to register and submit the required documents, and then organize the university to examine the eligible applicants;

- c) University Review
 - i. For Chinese Language Program applicants, the university will review their application documents and give the CLEC feedback on admission;
 - ii. For MTCSOL applicants, the university will review their application documents, and the School of Chinese Studies and Cultural Exchange will arrange an interview for those who pass the document review. Afterwards, the university will submit the admission list back to the CLEC.
- d) The CLEC will publish the final results. The applicants can log in the application system to check their final admission results. The admission results shall be subject to those published on the CLEC system.
- 5. Matters Needing Attention

 - b) Please do not apply for ICLTS and CGS at the same time.

III. Confucius China Studies Program (CCSP)

- 1. Application receiving agency: Department of CCSP, CLEC
- 2. Application time: December to February of the next year
- 3. Scholarship Types
 - a) Sino-Foreign Joint Ph.D. Sub-Program (Senior Visiting Student)
 - b) Ph.D. in China Sub-Program (Ph.D. Student)
- 4. Application Procedures

The CLEC organizes the registration and pre-review for the applicants. Then the university will review the application, arrange the interview, and send the admission list back to CLEC. The CLEC will organize the grand interview and notify the final admission results to the applicants.

- 5. Matters Needing Attention
 - a) For detailed information on program introduction, application requirements and procedures, answers to frequently asked questions and the contacts of the CLEC, please refer to the CCSP system: <u>ccsp.chinese.cn</u>;
 - b) The Major and Supervisor List shall be subject to information published on the CCSP system: <u>ccsp.chinese.cn</u>;

IV. Beijing Municipal Government Scholarship for International Students (New Students)

- 1. The scholarship is given in the form of tuition coverage or reduction.
- 2. Support Amount
 - a) Tuition coverage:

The full amount of the tuition fee of the first academic year will be covered.

b) Tuition reduction:

The half-amount of the tuition fee of the first academic year will be covered.

3. The scholarship is aimed at new international students of degree programs.

4. How to apply?

Due to the differences of work procedures and schedules between the undergraduate program and postgraduate programs, the application procedures of the scholarship also differ between the programs.

- a) The undergraduate program applicant shall submit the application on the RUC
 Online Application System for International Students after receiving the pre admission notice and paying the tuition fee of the first year online;
- b) The postgraduate programs applicant shall download the *Application Form for Scholarship & Award for Renmin University of China New International Students* on the website of ISO, and then fill out the form as required and send it along with the application documents to ISO.
- 5. The university will review the application according to the scholarship awarding regulations and ISO will publish the final list.
- 6. Matters Needing Attention:
 - a) All the scholarship applicants must pay the tuition fee of the first academic year in advance. If you obtain the scholarship, the tuition fee will be refunded;
 - b) One may apply for the Beijing Municipal Government Scholarship for International Students (hereinafter referred to as BMGS-IS) as well as CGS, ICLTS or CCSP at the same time, but could not obtain any two of them at the same time. The BMGS-IS shares the same application form with Renmin University of China Outstanding International Students Award (hereinafter referred to as RUC-OISA). One may apply for BMGS-IS and RUC-OISA at the same time (preference should be stated on the form), but could not obtain both;

V. Renmin University of China Outstanding International Students Award (New Students)

- 1. The scholarship is a **one-time award** given after registration.
- 2. Support amount: RMB 20000 yuan or 40000 yuan
- 3. The scholarship is aimed at new international students of **degree programs**.
- 4. Application Procedures

The applicant shall download the *Application Form for Scholarship & Award for Renmin University of China New International Students* on the website of ISO, and then fill out the form as required and send it along with the application documents to ISO. The university will review the application according to the relevant regulations and ISO will publish the final list.

- 5. Matters Needing Attention
 - a) The award cannot be used to waive your tuition fee. It must be given after the student registers and pays the tuition fee of the first academic year;
 - b) One may apply for the RUC-OISA as well as CGS, ICLTS or CCSP at the same time, but could not obtain any two of them at the same time. The RUC-OISA shares the same application form with BMGS-IS. One may apply for BMGS-IS and RUC-OISA at the same time (preference should be stated on the form), but could not obtain both;
