

2024 Silk Road Chinese Government Scholarship Application Guide

I. Sponsorship Categories

Undergraduate, Master's, and Doctoral Students

II. Sponsorship Period

The duration of funding is consistent with the basic duration of study, which is 4 years for undergraduate students, 2 or 3 years for master's students, and 4 years for doctoral students.

III. Sponsored Majors and Countries

According to the approval of the China Scholarship Council, the sponsored majors and countries for the 2024 "Silk Road" program at RUC are as follows:

Majors (including Chinese-taught undergraduate, master's, doctoral majors, and English-taught master's majors):

International Relations, Journalism and Communication, Business Administration, Finance, and Economics;

Countries: Malaysia, South Korea, Russia, Vietnam, Mongolia, Thailand, Indonesia, Cambodia, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan.

V. Application Conditions

(1) Academic and Age Requirements

Applicants for a bachelor's degree should have completed high school education with excellent academic performance and generally be under 25 years old.

Applicants for a master's degree should have a bachelor's degree or equivalent, with excellent academic performance and generally be under 35 years old.

Applicants for a doctoral degree should have a master's degree or equivalent, with excellent academic performance and generally be under 40 years old.

(2) Complete application in RUC system

Students applying for the "Silk Road" scholarship must have submitted their application through the *Renmin University of China International Student Application System* and have been admitted by RUC as self-support students.

VI. Application Process

Applicants must carefully read the *Instruction for Chinese Government Scholarship Information System (CGSIS) for Applicants* and log in to the CGSIS (<https://studyinchina.csc.edu.cn/#/login>) before **BJT May 26, 24:00**. Finish the "Chinese Government Scholarship Application Form" and submit application materials online.

Tips: 1) Choose "Type B" for Silk Road Program;

2) Institution code of RUC is 10002.

3) CSC only accepts applications recommended by universities and does not accept direct applications from students.

After completing the application in CSCIS, download the *Chinese Government Scholarship Application Form*, sign it and send the scanned electronic version to iso@ruc.edu.cn , with the email subject as: Silk Road Scholarship Application + Name + Undergraduate/Chinese Master/English Master/PhD + CSC Serial Number. **Those who do not send emails by 24:00 on May 26 will not be accepted by our university.**

The university will conduct a comprehensive assessment of students who have submitted scholarship applications in the CSC system, determine the recommended list, and submit it to the China Scholarship Council.

After the China Scholarship Council determines the final scholarship recipients, the admission results will be announced in the CSC system, and applicants can log in to the system to check.

VII. Notes

Each applicant can only apply for or be awarded one type of CSC scholarship.

Scholarship recipients are not allowed to change the admitted institution after coming to China and are not allowed to change the study major and period in principle.

Chinese Government Scholarship students are not allowed to enjoy other scholarships established by governments at all levels in China and the admitting institutions (excluding various one-time awards) at the same time; once discovered, their Chinese Government Scholarship qualification will be canceled, and they must return the Chinese Government Scholarship received. For those who deliberately conceal the funding situation, in addition to canceling the qualification, they are not allowed to apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship within three years.

If students are disqualified due to other reasons after the admission decision was made, the scholarship will be cancelled as well.
