2025 Enrollment Guide of CSC Scholarship

High-Level Postgraduate Program

I. Introduction

The program is designed to finance the study of talented international students in China that are directly selected and recommended by designated Chinese universities. High-Level Postgraduate Program sponsors master's and doctoral students.

II. Scholarship Coverage and Standard

The duration of the scholarship conforms to that as required: two or three years for master's degree and four years for doctoral degree.

The High-Level Postgraduate Program provides a full scholarship which covers tuition fees, on-campus accommodation, comprehensive medical insurance and stipend. Please refer to <u>Application Guide for Chinese Government Scholarship</u> for more information.

III. Application Qualifications

Applicants should:

- 1. NOT have Chinese nationality, and hold a valid ordinary passport.
- 2. Be physically and mentally healthy. Not have criminal record.
- 3. Requirement of age and diploma:
 - a) Master program applicants should be under 35 and hold a Bachelor's degree or equivalent.
 - b) Doctoral program applicants should be under 40 and hold a Master's degree or equivalent.
- 4. Applicants should meet the application requirements in the 2025 Enrollment Guide on Master Program in Chinese for International Students of Renmin University of China, 2025 Enrollment Guide on Ph.D. Program in Chinese for International Students of Renmin University of China, 2025 Enrollment Guide on Master Program in English for International Students of Renmin University of China, and 2025 Global Communication Ph.D. Program in English and submit the required application materials.
- 5. According to the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China and <u>the Letter</u> <u>No.12 [2020] of the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China</u>, certain applicants shall provide additional materials as National Proof Documents. Please refer to the document mentioned above.

IV. Application Procedure

1. Applicants must log into *International Students Application System of Renmin University of China* http://international.ruc.edu.cn/application within the application time, fill in the application information authentically, upload the application materials and pay the application fee online in the system. The application fee is RMB 800. The application fee will not be refunded.

Please complete your application by 15th February 2025. Late application will not be processed.

- 2. After the qualification review, the school will review the application documents. Applicants will get the interview notice if the check of the application documents is approved. The university issues *Admission Letter* for applicants who pass the interview and comprehensive assessment.
- 3. Register in the *Chinese Government Scholarship Information System* (here in after referred to as "CSC") https://studyinchina.csc.edu.cn. Fill out the application information, submit the completed *Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship* online, and upload all the required documents.

- 4. The final name result will be issued by the China Scholarship Council.

Notes:

- 1. All application documents shall be in Chinese / English and will not be returned once submitted.
- 2. Uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic and valid. Applicants are recommended to use a professional device to scan the relevant documents. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.
- 3. The university does not accept applicants who hold the following documents to apply as international students: Travel Permit of the People's Republic of China, Exit Entry Permit of the People's Republic of China, Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao Residents, Mainland Travel Permit for Taiwan Residents, Residence Permit for Hong Kong, Macao/Taiwan Residents of the People's Republic of China, etc.
- 4. Applicants are not allowed to change the passport or personal information from the date of application until 3 months after onsite registration. The personal information includes name, gender, date of birth, nationality, passport number, etc. If it was unavoidable to change passport or personal information due to extremely special circumstances or force majeure, a written application should be submitted to the

University for the Consent from the university. If the identity documents and personal information submitted by the applicants did not match the personal information provided during the application and admission process, the university will turn down the enrollment procedures.

VI. Campuses and Majors

According to the university charter, our institution operates across the Zhongguancun Campus, Tongzhou Campus and Suzhou campus.

For majors, please refer to the Chinese Government Scholarship Information System.

VII. Others

- 1. Each applicant can only be approved for one Chinese Government Scholarship program.
- 2. Scholarship recipients are not allowed to change the admitted institution after arriving in China, and in principle, not allowed to change the major or duration.
- 3. Chinese Government Scholarship students are not eligible to receive funding from other scholarships established by governments at all levels in China and their admitted institutions simultaneously (excluding various one-time awards). If discovered, their Chinese Government Scholarship qualification will be revoked, and they must return any received scholarship funds. For those who deliberately conceal their funding situation, in addition to disqualification, they will not be allowed to apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship for three years.
- 4. If it is found that there are other situations that do not meet the requirements of the China Scholarship Council and university's scholarship student recruitment after admission, the Chinese Government Scholarship qualification will be revoked.
- 5. International Students Office reserves the right of final interpretation of this enrollment guide. If there are any changes in the relevant enrollment information, please refer to the latest information released by International Students Office.
