

Scholarships

- **Chinese Government Scholarship:** The Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS) scheme provides full scholarship and partial scholarship to the international students studying in China. Full scholarships cover tuition, accommodation, living allowance and medical insurance, etc. Partial scholarships cover some proportions of tuition, accommodation, living allowance and medical insurance. - **Beijing Government Scholarship:** The Beijing Government Scholarship (BGS) is established by Beijing Municipal Government to attract and support excellent foreign students to study in Beijing. It is used to cover the tuition fees fully or partially, and needs to be applied year by year.
- **CCSP Scholarship:** The CCSP scholarship is established by the program to support the students to study in our program. Every new intakes who do not apply the double degree can be provided an half scholarship from the program, and the program provide full scholarship for 10% applicants. The scholarship used to cover the tuition fees fully or partially.

Program Description

- Contemporary China Studies program(CCSP) is the first English program in Renmin University of China. It offers overseas students not yet proficient in Chinese language the opportunity to study Chinese governance and foreign relations while living in China's capital city. CCSP recruits students from all over the world, fostering a unique multidisciplinary and multinational environment in which diverse backgrounds and experiences enhance rigorous academic study.
- During two years' study here, you can :
 1. Have the chance to get a comprehensive introduction to the economy, politics, law, society, and foreign policy of contemporary China.
 2. Have the chance to visit Chinese most important think tanks, top research institutions and some famous companies and NGOs.
 3. Have the chance to study with the students from different cultures, there are around 100 students from more than 20 different countries joined the program.
 4. Have the chance to get double degrees in two years. We have established the cooperation with King's College of London, UK and Kyunghee University of Korea. - CCSP resides within the School of International Studies , Renmin University of China. It is one of the earliest institutes engaging in the teaching and researches of political science and international affairs. With enduring efforts made by generations of scholars in the past sixty years, the School has built strong academic traditions and accumulated invaluable historical experiences and thus made itself as a leading and influential teaching and research base in the fields of political science and international studies in China.

Eligibility

- The applicants should provide an evidence of English proficiency in one of the following ways: iBT TOEFL score of 98 or above, TOEIC score of 900 or above, or IELTS 6.5 or above, or an equivalent score of any official English proficiency test or the certificate of graduating from a program taught in English.

Deadline

- March 25 for who want to apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship or Beijing Government Scholarship.
- June 10 for all the applicants.

Admission Procedure

- Send the scan copy of the application form and all the other application materials (see below) to chinastudies@ruc.edu.cn
- Interview: The coordinator will contact you for the details.
- Pre admission letter: The scan copy of the pre-admission letter will be sent within two weeks after the interview
- Admission letter: The official admission will be mailed to you after June 15

Application Materials

- Academic credentials (official transcripts)**
 - Applicants are required to hold a B.A. or B.S. degree (or equivalent) from an accredited college or university and a strong undergraduate record.
- Copy of undergraduate diploma (if available)**
 - For applicants who have not yet finished their undergraduate programme, the offer of admission will be contingent on successful completion of their degree prior to entry.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation**
 - It's better that the recommenders send email directly to ccsp.
- Proof of English language proficiency**
 - Students should submit the certificate of your English Level as required in 'Eligibility' above.

5. Non-refundable application fee of 600 CNY

- Please contact the coordinator of the program (chinastudies@ruc.edu.cn) for instructions on how to submit payment. DO NOT send cash or check with your application materials.
